



Arthur "Otts" Heinefield

July 9, 1935 - January 31, 2009

Arthur L. "Otts" Heinefield of Rock Hall, Maryland died on January 31, 2009 at Christiana Hospital. He was 73.

He was born in Rock Hall, MD on July 9, 1935 the son of the late Frank and Annie "Boots" Watson Heinefield. Following the death of his father Mr. Heinefield went to work as a self employed waterman at the age of sixteen. He worked the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries harvesting oysters, crabs, clams, and fish until his retirement.

Mr. Heinefield enjoyed woodworking and boatbuilding; he built his own work boat 40 footer and other smaller bateaus.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Jane Brady Heinefield, a daughter: Debbie Christian of Rock Hall, MD, a sister Laura "Dean" Puppe of Rock Hall, MD, grandchildren John Christian of Centreville, MD, and Brandon Turner of Delaware along with three great grandchildren: Sydney, Jake, and Damien. A daughter, the late Tammy Heinefield predeceased him on June 1, 2001.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, February 4, 2009 at 1:00PM at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home Route #20 Rock Hall, MD where relatives and friends may call one hour prior (12-1).
