



Arthur Warren Slaughter

August 24, 1944 - April 6, 2009

Arthur Warren Slaughter, beloved husband, father, brother, uncle, and friend, died Monday, April 6th, at Easton Memorial Hospital as the result of head injuries sustained in an auto accident. He was 64 years old.

Born August 24, 1944 in Easton, Maryland, he was the son of the late, Lorraine and Clifton Slaughter whom he cherished, both from Kent County. He had an adventurous, wonderful childhood growing up in Easton with his sister Joyce and his neighborhood little rascals. He graduated from Easton High School in 1963. Recently his class celebrated their 45th reunion and he so very much enjoyed being on the reunion committee and participating in all the reunion activities. Warren's class was very close and he felt a special bond with each member of his class. After high school, Warren attended Penn Technical Institute of Electronics in Pittsburgh, PA. He then felt called to serve his country and joined the U.S. Armed Forces, proud to be an American soldier. After being honorably discharged, he worked various jobs before choosing his career as a sales representative for the wines and spirits industry. He was employed by Reliable Churchill, LLLP in Baltimore, MD. As a beverage professional, Warren took pride in calling on his accounts and made every effort to provide excellent service.

In 1977, Warren married Linda Cunningham and they shared 31 wonderful years together. They were blessed with two beautiful, sweet, and gracious

daughters, Gretchen Gale and Stephanie Lorraine. Warren was very devoted to his family and enjoyed the many traditions and activities he was able to share with them. He was also blessed with many dear friends and cherished their bonds of friendship.

Warren was a member of the Royal Oak United Methodist Church, the Easton Elks Club, the American Legion Post 70, and the V.F.W., E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118. He loved to go to classic car and boat shows. An avid outdoorsman, Warren loved to fish and hunt. He loved nature, chickadees and nuthatches, would, without fear, perch on his hands to feed.

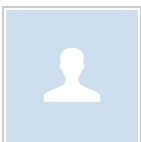
