



## Asa D. Tibbs

Asa D. Tibbs, of Hurlock, MD died on Friday, September 16, 2005 at Peninsula Regional Medical Center, Salisbury, MD. He was 80.

Born in Gladys, VA, December 31, 1924, he was one of eight children of the late John Mann and Lucy Mae Ferris Tibbs. After attending public school, he worked in Virginia in commercial construction. In 1952, he moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland where he worked as a commercial construction superintendent for the Hallock Construction Co. of Easton for 14 years and then with Charles E. Brohawn, Contractors, Cambridge, until 1973 when he moved to Port Charlotte, Florida where in addition to working for W.D. Mills Construction Company in Ft. Myers, he owned his own company, A.D.Tibbs Construction until retiring in 1981. He returned to the Hurlock area to make his home in June of 2000.

During World War II, Mr. Tibbs served in the U. S. Army in the European Theater of Operations and participated in several battles and campaigns including Northern France, Ardennes, Rhineland and Central Europe. He received two Purple Hearts for injuries received in battle as well as a Good Conduct Medal, World War II Victory Ribbon, the American Theater Ribbon and the European African Middle Eastern Ribbon.

Mr. Tibbs is survived by his wife, the former Faye Bowers, whom he married

April 24, 1947; three sons, Asa G. Tibbs of Salisbury, Dale L. Tibbs of Hagerstown and Lee H. Tibbs of Hurlock; a sister, Grace T. Roakes of Gladys, VA and nine grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, September 22, 2005 at 2:30 PM at the Chapel of the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery at Beulah. Burial, will full military honors, will follow at the cemetery.
