June 3, 1922 - March 30, 2010

Easton – A. Ted Soldano died on Tuesday, March 30, 2010. He was 87 years old.

Born in Washington, DC on June 3, 1922, he was the son of the late Maria Aspeslagh and Agostino T. Soldano, Sr. During World War II, Mr. Soldano served for three years with the U.S. Army Air Corps and was honorably discharged in 1946. He then joined the service team that manually switched manufactured gas to natural gas in Washington, D.C. Mr. Soldano was employed with the Washington Gas Light Company for 36 years and retired in 1982 as their Industrial Representative.

Spending his early years on the Chesapeake Bay instilled in Mr. Soldano a lifelong interest in boating. He enjoyed his home on the water, building and maintaining a series of boats, and coaching his children in swimming . He was a member of the B.O.E. #622, Annapolis Fleet Reserve, and the Lake Ogleton Yacht Club.

Mr. Soldano is survived by his loving wife, Rosemary Soldano; his children: Laurel Weaver, Jennifer Russell (Jim Gibbs), F. Mark Soldano (Julie Lowe), and Christopher Soldano (Carolyn Soldano); and his grandchildren: Julie Mc Pherson, Elizabeth Rose Soldano, Andrew Soldano, Matthew Soldano, and Peter Soldano.

A Celebration of Life service will be held at 11:00 am on Friday, April 9, 2010 at the Old Wye Parish Church in Wye Mills, MD.

Burial will be private.
