Aubrey A. Stinson, Sr. of Cordova, MD died on Friday, February 28, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD. He was 81.

Born October 22, 1921 in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late Walter and Annie Vestey Stinson. After graduating from Cordova High School in 1940, he served in the U.S. Army as a Military Policeman in Europe. Following his release from active duty he began a lifelong career as a farmer until his retirement October 1, 1986.

He was a member of the Talbot County Farm Bureau, Tri-County Ruritan, a former supervisor of the Talbot County Ag Center and a member of Easton Elks Lodge #1622.

Mr. Stinson is survived by his wife, the former Maryanne Hurley, whom he married June 20, 1959; a daughter, Katherine Ann Stinson of Timmonsville, SC; two sons, Aubrey A. "Chip" Stinson, Jr. and his fiancée, Sandy Spedden of Easton, and John Walter "Skip" Stinson and his wife, Susan of Cordova; adopted son and grandson, Lance Corporal Kevin A. Stinson USMC, stationed in Kuwait and a grandson, John Walter "Jack" Stinson, Jr. of Cordova; a sister Dorothy Voshell of Easton and numerous nieces and nephews. He was pre-deceased by a sister, Muriel Unruh and a brother, Handley Stinson.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, March 6, 2003 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Greenmount Cemetery, Hillsboro, MD.
