



Aubrey Fred Goodwin, Sr.

April 6, 1926 - September 28, 2009

Oxford: Aubrey F. Goodwin, Sr. of Oxford died on Tuesday, September, 29, 2009 at Memorial Hospital in Easton. He was 83.

Born in Argyle Sound, Nova Scotia, Canada on April 6, 1926, he was the son of the late Richard H. and Fanny M. Goodwin. After attending school, Mr. Goodwin entered the Canadian Merchant Marines where he served the Allies in World War Two from 1943-1946 making several Transatlantic voyages.

After becoming a United States citizen he was drafted into the United States Army where he served until 1952 including service in the Korean War.

Following his release from active duty, Mr. Goodwin worked as a sailing yacht captain. Later he worked for the Scott Paper Company for more than fourteen years as well as for the Sun Oil Company for nine years before retiring. Mr. Goodwin loved sailing and raced to Bermuda several times. He was a long time resident of Oxford, having moved there in the 1950s. Mr. Goodwin was a member of the Oxford United Methodist Church and was a past member of the Oxford Volunteer Fire Company.

Mr. Goodwin is survived by his loving wife Nora Hubbard Goodwin of Oxford, four nieces, one nephew, and many friends.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a son, Aubrey Fred Godwin, Jr., and a brother, Cecil Goodwin.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, October 5, 2009 at the Oxford United Methodist Church, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be held at the Oxford Cemetery.
