



## Audrey Lorraine Carder-Thurman

March 20, 1936 - February 19, 2022

Audrey Lorraine Carder-Thurman from Silver Spring, MD, died Saturday, February 19, 2022, at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD, surrounded by her children. She was 85.

Born in White Plains, MD, on March 20, 1936, she was the daughter of the late William Cephas Barker and Olive Kendrick Barker.

Audrey grew up on a farm in Charles County, MD. After graduating from LaPlata High School in 1955, she ventured to Washington, DC, to attend Washington Hospital Center School of Nursing. One evening out with her nursing school girlfriends, she met her future husband James Homer Carder at a popular drive-in restaurant. The two married in 1957 and raised their four children in Silver Spring, MD. She continued her nursing career, first at Washington Hospital Center, then Holy Cross Hospital where she retired at age 60 in 1996.

Throughout her retirement, she loved spending time with her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. Audrey made many friends where she lived independently. She spoke fondly of the close community, the many activities they enjoyed together, and how everyone looked out for each other.

Audrey is survived by her children, Catherine Settle (Bruce, Sr.) of

Stevensville, MD, Carol Anderson (Maurice) of Selbyville, DE, William Carder of Silver Spring, MD, and Connie Cannon (Dave Garrett) of Selbyville, DE; six grandchildren, Chrisie Cannon Mount (Brad), Christopher Cannon (Barbara), William Anderson (Christina), Maurine Hainsworth (Nate), Carl Anderson, and Blake Settle (Hannah); and eight great-grandchildren, Karlee, Rylee, Brody, Brooke, Aubree, Wesley, Annabell and Nora. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her sisters, Jeannie Barker and Shirley Benincasa; grandson, Bruce Settle, Jr.; her husband, Dennis Thurman; and her former husband, James Carder.
