



Audrey B. Stubbs

March 20, 1918 - November 25, 2018

Audrey B. Stubbs of Rock Hall, MD, died on November 25, 2018, at The Resorts at Chester River Manor. She was 100.

She was born in Baltimore on March 20, 1918, to Thomas and Marie Burke.

Mrs. Stubbs was a graduate of Eastern High School and attended the Maryland Institute of Art where she became a skilled artist in ceramics and oil paintings. She also studied at Johns Hopkins University and worked as a draftsman at Glen L. Martin Company.

Mrs. Stubbs enlisted in the Women's Army Corps during World War II and earned the rank of Staff Sergeant with the Army, her primary duty was as draftsman. While serving her country, she married Arthur W. Stubbs, a draftsman with the Army Signal Corps, whom she had met while working at Glen L. Martin.

Mrs. Stubbs was sent to the CBI in September of 1945 and her husband followed in December of that same year, all that she knew was his APO address. Upon arriving at his destination, he inquired as to where her APO was located and discovered they were eight miles apart. After several conferences with their respective C.O.'s they were given a five-day furlough in New Delhi. Mrs. Stubbs often referred to this as "the nicest Christmas present

ever.” They were both members of Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion Post #228, Rock Hall.

Mrs. Stubbs was an accomplished artist, phenomenal athlete and astute gardener. One of her proudest accomplishments was that she and her husband hiked the entire Appalachian Trail.

Her husband predeceased her February 12, 1996, and was interred with honors in the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery.

She is survived by a sister, Doris B. Dunker of Severna Park, MD; and two nieces, Jennifer Lucas of Ellicott City, MD and Wendy Tatter of St. Augustine, FL.

Military Honors will be performed at Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD, on Friday, November 30, 2018, at 1 p.m.
