



## Audrey Stayton Woolston

June 26, 1927 - November 28, 2017

Audrey Stayton Woolston, 90, passed away on November 28, 2017, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton, MD.

Born on June 26, 1927 in Neavitt, MD, she was the daughter of the late George Williamson Stayton and Lydia George Richardson. She was a 1944 graduate of Easton High School. She received her BS in Elementary Education from Salisbury State Teacher's College (Salisbury University). She was voted Miss STC and was a Key Recipient. She furthered her studies at University of Maryland, Loyola. Audrey taught school for 30 years, 28 of those in Talbot County. She was a member of the Talbot County Public Schools Personnel Association and served as Treasurer and Member-at-Large. She was a Life Member of the National Education Association.

She married William Price Woolston on April 10, 1948, and they made their home in Easton.

A Charter Member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Audrey was a past member of the United Methodist Women and leader of Miriam Circle. She worked at St. Mark's Thrift Shop and Food Pantry. Audrey was very well-traveled, having visited most of the United States and more than 28 foreign countries.

She is survived by her children, Dale Dowling of Frederick, Stephen Woolston

of Cambridge, Victoria Smoot of St. Michaels, and Adrienne Hyatt of Easton; nine grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

Visitation will be held on Saturday, December 2, 2017, from 10 a.m. – 11 a.m. at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton, followed by a funeral service at 11 a.m. Interment will be private.
