Augustus R. Dabroski “Gus” passed away after a brief illness on Saturday, May 29, 2010. He was 84.

Gus was born on September 26, 1925 in Morganville, NJ. He was the son of the late, Casmir and Anna Dabroski. After he was drafted and served in the U.S. Navy during World War II, he graduated from St. John’s University in New York with a Bachelors Science Degree in pharmacy, and worked as a pharmacist until he retired. Formerly from East Brunswick, NJ Gus and Winnie, his wife of 52 years, have resided in St. Michaels since 1998.

In retirement he loved to play the piano, sketch with charcoals and paint with watercolors and acrylics. He was also a woodcarver and made numerous pieces of fine furniture. Another one of Gus’ talents was his ability to bake; he baked for the Blue Crab Coffee Co. until his death.

In addition to his wife Winnie, Gus is also survived by two sons, Bob and Michael whom he resided with in St. Michaels; his daughter, Mary and her partner Jane; his daughter, Winnie and her husband, Dave of New Hope, PA and their four children, Sam, Jackie, Henry, and Charlie.
