



Augustus P. Clarson Jr.

Augustus P. "Gus" Clarson, Jr. of Easton, MD died on Monday, September 22, 2003 at North Arundel Hospital, Glen Burnie, MD. He was 84.

Born January 1, 1919 in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Augustus P. and Bessie Eaves Clarson, Sr. He attended grammar school in Overbrook, PA and Episcopal Academy in Merion, PA. After graduating from Lower Merion High School in 1936, he was employed by a real estate agency in West Philadelphia. He served in the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II from November 1943 to February 1946, participating in the American Campaign and Asiatic Pacific Campaign. Following the war he spent 37 years in banking, in Philadelphia, Arvada, Colorado and Clearwater, Florida.

Gus, as he was affectionately known, was an adult leader in Boy Scouts of America for 35 years and attended two national jamborees, in Valley Forge, PA and Mt. Ranier Park, Washington. His many scouting awards included the prestigious Silver Beaver Award.

He joined the Oxford Volunteer Fire Dept. in 1934 and was a member of Philadelphia Second Alarmers, crew chief of Springfield, PA Ambulance Corps, and was photographer for the Easton Vol. Fire Department, where he was a life member. He served as Security Officer for the Talbot County Library from 1982 until 1989.

Mr. Clarson is survived by his wife Dorothy M. Clarson; a daughter, Barbara Mullikin and her husband, Terry of Easton, MD; a son, Robert Clarson of Wellsboro, PA; four grandchildren, Tracy Connolly of Pasadena, MD, Jennifer Michael of North Redington Beach, FL, and Shawn and Laura Clarson of Wellsboro, PA; two step-daughters, Carol Partain of Boise Idaho and Marian Ward of Venice, FL, and a step-son, Steve Markel, of Dover, DE.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, September 26, 2003 at 4:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD. where friends may call from 3:00-4:00PM

Private inurnment will be at the Oxford Cemetery Columbarium, Oxford, MD.
