Austin Wayne Hill, of Easton, died at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD on Friday, August 27, 2004. He was 70.

Born in Vineland, NJ, November 12, 1933, he was the son of the late Austin Tracy and Ruth Harris Hill. After graduating from Vineland High School in 1949, he attended Valley Forge Military Academy and then the Pennsylvania Military Academy from which he graduated with degrees in Business and Civil Engineering. He then served in the U. S. Army as a Ranger and with the Airborne. Following his release from active duty, he became a member of the New Jersey National Guard. Later in life, he earned his Master's Degree in Construction Engineering from the University of Delaware.

Early in his engineering work, he helped build Alligator Alley in Florida and the Haunted Mansion at Disney World. He then went into hospital construction with the Middle Atlantic Co. in Baltimore and spent five years in Iran, Iraq and Saudia Arabia. He was then associated with American Medical International of Beverly Hills, CA in their Tampa, FL office and then, for seventeen years, with the Athens Regional Medical Center in their Athens, GA office working in hospital construction. At the age of 62, after a brief retirement, he formed his own company, A. Wayne Hill Consulting Group, and, at the time of his death, was working with St. Agnes Hospital in Baltimore.

His professional memberships included Hospital Engineers of America. His hobby was collecting and driving Jaguar automobiles.

Mr. Hill is survived by his wife, the former Catherine L. Lonas whom he married August 17, 1978 in Columbia, MD; a daughter, Kelly Hill Brinkley and her husband, Bobby, of Valrico, FL; three step-daughters, Sheree Edwards and her husband, Raymond, of Annapolis, MD, Sandra Bonney and her husband, Charles, of Tampa, FL and Kim Zook of Silver Spring, MD; five grandchildren, Morgan Brinkley, Austin Brinkley, Blair Boggs, Scott Edwards and Troy Edwards.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, August 31st, at 11 A. M. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home. P.A., Easton.

Burial will be at the Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD
