



## Avonell Havrilla Jones

September 24, 1948 - May 21, 2023

Avonell Havrilla Jones of Lynchburg, VA, formerly of Easton, MD, died on May 21, 2023. She was 74 years old.

Mrs. Jones was born in Washington, DC, to Frank and Eloise Oursler Havrilla on September 24, 1948. She grew up in the Forest Heights area of Maryland. She met her husband William “Gordon” Jones when they both worked for a car dealership in Hagerstown, MD – she did the books, and he was a mechanic.

The couple moved to Easton on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, where she was employed by the Oxford Boatyard for 30 years.

Mrs. Jones was a volunteer for the Lynchburg Public Library, and she loved to travel, especially to the Outer Banks of North Carolina where her sister lived. She also enjoyed going to see her nieces and supporting them in their various band activities, including football games and parades. She treasured holiday gatherings with her family, especially Thanksgiving. She moved to Lynchburg, VA, in 2014 to be closer to her family.

One of her greatest thrills was flying in a Red Baron plane on her 65th birthday, flying over the beaches of the Outer Banks, including right over her sister’s home.

Mrs. Jones is survived by her sister, Stacy Murphy; her brother-in-law, Scott Murphy; her brother, Craig Havrilla; and seven nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, William Gordon Jones, in 2008.

A graveside service will be held at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton at 11 a.m. on Thursday, May 25, 2023.
