Barbara Slater Frank, of Stevensville Maryland went home to be with our Lord, Friday, December 1st, 2023. She was 81 years old.

Born Barbara Anne Slater to Hubert and Vera Slater, on August 13th, 1942, in Providence Rhode Island. A 1960 graduate of East Providence High School, East Providence, R.I., Barbara went on to attend Ohio Wesleyan University where she was a member of Alpha Chi Omega sorority and earned her Bachelors in Elementary Education in 1964. Barbara's charm and elegance shone as bright as her fiery red hair. Soon after graduating, she attracted the gaze of a young naval officer, LT JG Winn Beaudoin Frank, USNR.
