



Barbara Phillips Jackson

November 25, 1934 - November 21, 2014

Barbara Phillips Jackson, 79, beloved mother, grandmother, teacher, and friend passed away November 21, 2014, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore.

Barbara was born on November 25, 1934, to Frank and Dorothy (MacCauley) Phillips in Montclair, NJ. Upon graduating high school in Montclair, she attended Western Maryland College where she obtained her first Bachelor of Arts degree.

After many years as a stay-at-home mother, Barbara returned to school, attending Washington College and earning her BA in Elementary Education. She became a first grade teacher at Kent Island Elementary School where she taught for almost 30 years. She also returned to Washington College and earned her Master's Degree in Education in 1985.

Barbara loved children, and before becoming a school teacher, she taught piano; gave swimming lessons in the summer; became active in many local civic organizations, including the PTA, Girl Scouts, and Boy Scouts. During her teaching career, she worked many summers caring for babies at the Sudlersville Migrant Workers Program.

She was a long-time member of Centreville United Methodist Church where

she was a director and member of the church choir. She also played in the Hand Bell choir and sang in the Queen Anne Chorale. Barbara loved music, was an avid gardener, an enthusiastic sports fan, and devoted to her family.

Barbara is survived by her long-time companion Jack Simperts; her daughter, Linda Conley of Marathon, FL; her son, Bill Jackson and wife Lisa of Ulen, MN; her son, Chris Jackson of Centreville; grandchildren John and Eric Thomas, Adam Jackson and Karlee Tiesler; and great-grandchildren, Gabriel and Ethan Thomas. She was preceded in death by her parents and brother Bill of Toms River, NJ. A celebration of Barbara's life will be held on January 17, 2015, at 1 p.m. at Centreville United Methodist Church.
