



## Barbara L. Murphy

June 14, 1929 - February 23, 2016

Barbara Leverage Murphy of Easton, MD, died on February 23, 2016, at the UMSMC at Easton. She was 86.

Born on June 14, 1929, in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Clarence John Leverage and Elise Mae Dixon Leverage. Mrs. Murphy graduated from Easton High School in the Class of 1946, and was a lifelong resident of Easton. She served in the US Air Force from 1949 to 1952. She was employed with the State of Maryland as a Child Support Enforcement Agent, a position from which she retired in 2006 after 27 years of service. For the last 15 years, she was employed with Heartfields at Londonderry.

She was a member of the VFW Post 151 and the American Legion Post 70.

Mrs. Murphy is survived by her son, Mark Dixon Murphy of Ocean City, MD; her sisters, Anne Angello of Easton, MD, and Doris Leverage of Easton, MD; several nieces and nephews; and her loving granddoggie, Ollie. She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles Francis Murphy.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, February 27 at the First Baptist Church of Easton. Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park.
