Greensboro – Barbara Anne Heulings Norman passed away Sunday evening, September 19, 2010, with her husband and children by her side.

Barbara was born Sept. 27, 1937 in Philadelphia, PA to Kathryn and William Heulings. She attended Wilson College, followed by the University of Pennsylvania, graduating with a BA in Economics. After marrying and raising her children, she returned to school to earn an Associate's Degree as a Medical Assistant.

Barbara spent a lot of time volunteering. Her volunteer work began in the Talbot County Schools as a Treasurer, Secretary, and Vice President of the St. Michaels High School PTA. She was proud to have been given a life membership in the MD Congress of Parents and Teachers. Her volunteer work continued as a tutor in the St. Michaels schools, a volunteer in several libraries, and then branched into healthcare as a volunteer with The Memorial Hospital at Easton, Shore Health Systems, Caroline Hospice, Riddle Memorial Hospital, and Horizon's Unlimited Geriatric Education Corp. Later she added work with the Board of Elections in Greensboro, MD.

Barbara is survived by her husband of 51 years, Dick Norman, her daughter, Bobbie Findlay and her husband, Brian, daughter Kathy Norman, son, Hank Norman and his wife, Cathy Becker, and son Tjark Norman and his wife, Lis.
