Barbara Lou Pierce, 78, of Stevensville, MD, died on March 9, 2014, at Hospice of Queen Anne's.

Born in Washington, DC, on March 12, 1935, she was the daughter of the late Francis J. and Callie Janet Mullen Reese. She graduated from Washington Lee High School in Arlington, VA, as a member of the Class of 1953.
