June 20, 1936 - August 14, 2014

Barbara Ann “Bibby” Price of Easton, MD, and formerly of Trappe, MD, died on Thursday, August 14, 2014, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. She was 78.

Born on June 20, 1936 in Philadelphia, PA, she was the daughter of the late Elmar Stroud Callahan and Mildred Cecelia Skinner Callahan.

Mrs. Price graduated from Easton High School in 1954. She married Robert “Bobby” Price on December 23, 1954. Barbara spent the first 17 years of their marriage as a military wife and mother, traveling and living in different places, including Texas, Delaware, Okinawa, Michigan, and Arizona before settling in Trappe.

“Bibby” enjoyed spending time with her family, cooking, crocheting “Bibby” blankets for the new babies in her family and close friends. She enjoyed making people laugh and going to lunch with friends. In recent years, she had become more involved with Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church activities and committees. She worked 17 years at White Marsh Elementary School as Cafeteria Manager. She was an Avon representative for 40 years. Although she has been living in Easton for several years, she always thought of Trappe as 'home' and loved all her Trappe friends.
