Barbara Grace Sposa died on Monday, September 21, 2015, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD. She was 76.

Born November 29, 1938, in Nyack, NY, she was the daughter of the late John B. and Dorothy Thompson McClain.

Barbara graduated from Dumont High School in Dumont, NJ, in 1956 and made the dean's list at Vermont Junior College, Montpelier, VT, graduating in 1958. Barbara married Robert J. Sposa on November 26, 1960, and they resided in Hillsdale, NJ, until moving to Easton, MD in 2002.

She trained at her profession of blood bank technician at Hackensack Hospital, Hackensack, NJ. Barbara then worked as Lead Technologist in the Blood Bank, Dept. of Pathology at Greenwich Hospital, Greenwich, CT, retiring after 40 years of service.

She was a member of the Talbot County Seniors.
