



## Barbara Jane Thomson

May 25, 1939 - July 10, 2017

Barbara Jane Thomson, 78, of Easton, MD, died on July 10, 2017, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. She was born on May 25, 1939, in Taylor, PA, the daughter of the late Vincent and Joanna Neiper.

She attended public school in Pittston, PA, and began working in the local pants factory. In 1958, she married Francis Hanahoe. They resided in Pittston until later moving to Washington, DC, in 1959. She attended Temple School of Business, graduating in 1966. She began working at NASA Goddard Space Center in 1969 and retired in 1995 as a data processing specialist. After her first marriage ended in divorce, she married John "Jack" Thomson on February 14, 1982, residing in Crofton, MD. In 1986, they moved to Grasonville, and, in 1999, to Easton.

She is survived by two sons, Richard Hanahoe and his wife, Ginger, and Steven Hanahoe; one sister, Joan Shandra; four grandchildren, Richard Hanahoe, Lauren Hanahoe, Sara Hanahoe and Michael Hanahoe.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Jack Thomson, who died just two days before on July 8, 2017, and a sister, Anne Burgio.
