Barbara Ellen Blunt of Queen Anne, MD died at Easton Hospital, Easton, MD on Thursday, February 5, 2004. She was 75.

Born December 1, 1928 in Chester, MD, she was the daughter of the late James Gilmore, Austin, Sr. and Drusilla Thomas Austin. She attended school in Chester and Stevensville area. She married Louis M. Blunt, Sr. of Chester on February 9, 1946. She was a homemaker and lived in the Grasonville area, at Perry's Corner Road. She also worked at cleaning houses for some time.
