Barbara Francis Lindsey, of Easton, died at Heartfields, Easton, on Sunday, November 6, 2005. She was 82.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, January 12, 1923, she was the daughter of the late Carl and Ruth Davis Francis. She was raised in Audubon, NJ where she graduated from Audubon High School as the Salutatorian of the Class of 1940. Following her graduation from Pierce Business School in Philadelphia, PA, she worked as the Executive Assistant for Mr. Paul, Sr. of Paul & Paul, Patent Attorneys. After her marriage to Erwin R. Lindsey on June 28, 1947, they moved to Delaware where she was employed with the DuPont nylon operations. In 1949, they moved to Virginia's Shenandoah Valley where they lived for two years before moving to Easton in 1951.

While raising her children, she worked at the Talbot County Court House. She volunteered extensively for the Junior Auxiliary at Memorial Hospital where she also served as President. She was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church as well as the Talbot Country Club.

A very active sports fan who especially loved the Baltimore Colts and the Orioles, she was also an accomplished bridge player who won many tournaments during her lifetime.

As an adult, she learned to play golf and truly enjoyed playing with her

husband and friends. The camaraderie enjoyed at any sporting activity was certainly the most significant aspect to her, but she also enjoyed the pleasure of a win.

She was a person who always loved having a fun with her family and friends. One always knew when she was in a room when they heard her wonderful and boisterous laughter.

A special and devoted wife, mother and friend who always thought of others first, she leaves a legacy of compassion and love.

Barbara Lindsey's husband of fifty-seven years, Erwin R. Lindsey, died June 11, 2003.

Surviving, are three sons, Richard A. Lindsey of Hopedale, MA, Jeffrey W. Lindsey of Potomac, MD and Robert F. Lindsey of Ruxton, MD and five grandchildren.

A Memorial Service will be held at St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton on Friday, November 11th, at 11 A.M.
