



## Beatrice Caroline Lowery

October 26, 1924 - April 13, 2014

The Lord called Beatrice Caroline Lowery home to His loving arms on Sunday, April 13, 2014. Mrs. Lowery died at Heartfields assisted living of Easton, MD. She was 89.

She was born in Washington, DC, on October 26, 1924, daughter of the late John Herbert Robinson and Lillie McQuay Robinson.

Mrs. Lowery graduated from Eastern High School in 1942 and Sibley Memorial Hospital Nursing School in Washington, DC, in 1945. During the Great Depression, she worked various jobs, including at Sibley Hospital, Southeast Orthopedics, and later at the U.S. Census Bureau Health Unit. She was a former member of Grace Baptist Church where she sang in the choir and taught Sunday school. She married Hugh H. Lowery in 1946. She was a former member of Easton Memorial Hospital Ladies Auxiliary and an Easton Waterfowl Festival volunteer.

She is survived by two sons, Jay Lowery and Chris Lowery; and four grandchildren, Brek, Clint, Megan and Brooke. She was preceded in death by her husband, Hugh Harding Lowery, who died September 30, 2012, and her brother, John H. Robinson Jr.

A brief chapel service will be held on Friday, April 18, 2014, at 11:00 A.M. at

the Maryland Eastern Shore Veteran's Cemetery near Hurlock.

A celebration of life service will be held at the First Wesleyan Church of Easton on April 18, 2014, at 2:00 P.M.
