



Beatrice W. Staton

Beatrice “Bea” W. Staton passed away on April 6, 2019, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton, MD. She was 86.

She was born on December 20, 1932, in Patapsco, MD, the daughter of the late Edward M. and Charlotte Muller Williams.

Mrs. Staton attended Easton High School graduating Class of 1951. She began working as a secretary at Cox Distributing until coming home to care for her children. In 1963, she began working at the Star Democrat in the darkroom, laying out the printing.

On April 5, 1975, she married Lloyd W. Staton, Sr., and they resided in Easton. In 1986, they moved to Denton, MD, and she began working at the Caroline Nursing Home and the Ruxton Health Center the following year. After that she worked for Comfort Keepers as a caregiver for a gentleman in Oxford.

Mrs. Staton was a member of the Calvary Baptist Church in Denton, where she was on the kitchen committee. She loved playing with her pets, reading, and helping others.

She is survived by three children, Danny K. Watkins, Kim Armstrong and Anita W. Macey; a brother, George E. Williams; seven grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, Lloyd W. Staton, Sr., and her son, Steven D. Watkins.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Wednesday, April 10, 2019, at Calvary Baptist Church, 1120 Market St., Denton, where friends may call one-hour prior from 10 a.m. – 11 a.m. Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery in Easton.
