A Funeral Liturgy for Belle W. Flynn of St. Michaels, MD will be celebrated on Wednesday April 23, 2003 at 12:00 Noon at St. Michaels Catholic Chapel, St. Michaels, MD. Mrs. Flynn entered into eternal peace on Friday, April 18, 2003 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 83.

Born in the West River area of Anne Arundel County on December 19, 1919, she was the daughter of the late James O. and Edith Shepherd Welch. After graduating from the Southern High School of Anne Arundel County in Lothian, MD in 1937, she attended Towson University for two years and then Mrs. Fleet's Business School for one year. On April 11, 1942 she married Capt. Russell F. Flynn, U.S.N. and they made their home in San Francisco, CA until 1966 when they moved to McLean, VA and in 1978 retired to St. Michaels, MD. She was a homemaker who was devoted to the care of her husband and children. While Capt. Flynn was serving as Commander of the U.S.S. Harold J. Ellison, a destroyer, Mrs. Flynn was awarded the honor of Destroyer Lady of The Year for her leadership of the other wives of destroyer personnel.

A member of Sts. Peter & Paul Parish, St. Michaels Catholic Chapel, she was also a member of the St. Ann and Joachin Society and the Women's Club of St. Michael's. She was a thirty-five year member of the General Perry Benson Chapter, National Society Daughters of The American Revolution, where she had served as Vice Reagent and for many years as Chaplain.

In addition to her husband of sixty-one years, Mrs. Flynn is survived by six children, Patricia Warstler of Reston, VA, Russell F. Flynn, Jr. of Norfolk, VA, Kathleen S. Hannigan of Towson, MD, Ellen C. Cooper of Easton, MD, John J.M. Flynn of Stephens City, VA and Henry Peter Flynn of Breezy Pt., MD; twelve grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
