



## Benard William Sparenberg Jr.

October 14, 1936 - July 28, 2013

Benard (Ben) William Sparenberg, Jr., 76, of Chester, MD, died on July 28, 2013, at his home on Kent Island.

Born on October 14, 1936, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Benard W. Sparenberg, Sr., and Sadie R. D. Sparenberg. He was a Security Officer for 20 years at Mercy Medical Center in Baltimore until his retirement in September 2012. Prior to that, he was a private Security Officer and a Private Investigator for two years each. He was the business manager for a thoroughbred horse-breeding farm in Monkton, MD, from 1982-1990. He served in the Army Reserves from 1955-1957 and was stationed in Korea.

He earned his Associates degree in Business Management from University of Baltimore in 1969, and was an active participant in the Towson High School Class of '55 Alumni.

He is survived by his children, Cherri Sparenberg (Tim Kempa) of Baltimore, MD; Patti Sparenberg (Deanna) of Chesapeake Beach, MD, and Ben Sparenberg, III; his grandchildren, Jana Sparenberg and Brian Sparenberg; a sister, Madeline Larmore (Ed) of Chester; MD; and a brother, Richard Sparenberg; and his wife, Sue Sparenberg of Seaford, DE.
