Benjamin Thomas Licwinko, Sr. of Rock Hall, Maryland died on Monday, October 14, 2002 at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in Chestertown, MD. He was 82.

Born in Philadelphia, PA on February 18, 1920, he was the son of the late Boleslaw' and Aleksandra Kotowska Licwinko. He was the husband for 56 years of the late Viola Rebecca Larrimore Licwinko who predeceased him on November 17, 2001.

Mr. Licwinko worked for over 25 years for B.F. Goodrich as a tool and die maker, residing in Jeffersonville, PA. He retired in December of 1980.
