Benjamin L. Miller, age 77, of Bel Air, MD, passed away on August 3, 2018, at his home. Born in Centreville, MD, he was the son of Joseph Perry Miller and Mary Catherine (Middleton) Ireland. He was predeceased by his wife of 52 years, Elizabeth Ann (Messick) Miller (Betsy), who was his high school sweetheart.

Mr. Miller retired as a Major with the Maryland Army National Guard in 1986 after 29 years of service. He then worked for Aberdeen Proving Ground for over 25 years where he held several positions including Security Manager for the U.S. Army Research Laboratory, Security Specialist for the Ballistics Research Laboratory, and Branch Chief of the Administrative Support Branch of the Human Engineering Laboratory. He enjoyed teasing and joking around with his granddaughters and spending time with his two poodles.
