Benjamin Sparks Todd of Queen Anne, MD, died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD, on Wednesday, January 23, 2002. He was 78.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on November 8, 1923, he was the son of the late A. Morris Todd, Sr. and Melvyna Sparks Todd. He graduated from Sparrows Plant High School in Baltimore County and later attended Randolph Macon Academy until he was called to serve in the U.S. Navy. During World War II, he served as a Quarter Master in both the Atlantic and Pacific on the U.S.S. Whipple DD217. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Baltimore County to work on the family vegetable farm. The family left Baltimore County in 1966 and moved to Ruthsburg, MD, again with the family vegetable farm known as Todd Brothers, Inc.

He was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church and the Queen Anne County Farm Bureau, the Queen Anne's Historical Society and the Ruthsburg Community Club. He also was a member of Easton Navy League and the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Mr. Todd is survived by his wife, Jean Blackman Todd of Queen Anne; two sons, Thomas B. Todd of Queen Anne and A. Philip Todd of Stevensville; a brother, A. Morris Todd, Jr. of Towson, MD; and two grandchildren, Ben Todd and Meghan Todd.

Private burial will be at Todd's Inheritance, Oak Lawn Cemetery, Baltimore, MD.
