



## Benjamin F. Brittingham Jr.

Benjamin “Ben” F. Brittingham, Jr. of Trappe, MD died on Wednesday, March 31, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 74.

Born April 6, 1929 in Salisbury, MD, he was the son of the late Benjamin F., Sr. and Delta Gordy Brittingham. After graduating from Cambridge High School, he attended Salisbury Normal School, now known as Salisbury University. From 1948 to 1951 he served in the United States Army. After his release from active duty, he began a career with McCrorys as store manager, where he dedicated 43 years of his life. He managed stores in several states and spent his last 21 years at the McCrory’s Store in Easton, MD, retiring in 1992.

A member of the Easton Lions Club, he had served in various capacities including King Lion. He was also a member of the American Legion in Hurlock and the E.E. Streets Memorial Post # 5118 V.F.W., Easton. He enjoyed traveling, especially to Cancun, playing the piano, listening to Big Band Music, shopping and spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren,

Mr. Brittingham is survived by his wife, the former Barbara Knipe, whom he married November 13, 1965; seven children, Lynne Burkhart of Martinsburg, W.VA, David Brittingham of York, PA, Benjamin “Benjie” Brittingham III and John Brittingham both of Easton, William Todd Brittingham of Rustburg, VA, Paula Snead and Melanie Brittingham both of Easton; a sister, Barbara Henry
