



## Benjamin Hayden Pentz Sr.

Benjamin Hayden Pentz, Sr., of St. Michaels, died at the Talbot Hospice House, Easton, on Sunday, January 7, 2001. He was 94.

Born in Baltimore, March 2, 1906, he was the son of the late Charles William and Angela Josephine Grossi Pentz. He was a graduate of Baltimore Polytechnic. The majority of his business life was spent in real estate and typewriter sales. He represented the Royal Typewriter Co. in the Midwest for a number of years and later owned and operated the Callaway Typewriter Co. in Salisbury, MD where he lived from 1958 until 1971.

Following the sale of that business, he moved to Talbot County where he was active in real estate sales until retiring in 1987. A member of Christ Church, St. Michaels, he was a former member of the Edge Creek Boat Club, the Miles River Yacht Club and the Talbot Dance Club.

Mr. Pentz is survived by his wife, the former Frances Louise Merryman whom he married in November of 1954; a brother, John A. Pentz of Easton and two grandchildren. A son, Benjamin Hayden Pentz, Jr., died in July of 1991.

Memorial services will be held at Christ Church, St. Michaels, on Wednesday, January 10th, at 2 p.m. Entombment will be in the Christ Church Columbarium.
