EASTON: Bennett Wayne Haley of Easton died on Sunday, March 15, 2009 at University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center in Baltimore. He was 17 years old.

Born Oct. 22, 1991 in Easton, he was the son of Gary & Jill Payne Haley. He attended SS Peter & Paul Elementary School from kindergarten through 8th grade. From his freshman year to the present he was a student at Easton High School where he was a junior. There he played JV Football, JV Soccer and JV Lacrosse and was presently a member of the Varsity Lacrosse team. He was an avid outdoorsman; loved hunting, fishing, boating, water sports and snow skiing as well as travelling to many places with his family. He also had future hopes for being accepted by the United States Coast Guard to serve his country.

In addition to his parents, Bennett is survived by a sister Arden Haley of Easton, MD, a brother Garrit Haley of Easton, MD; maternal grandmother Joan Payne of Easton, MD; paternal grandparents Wayne and Janet Ward Haley of Easton, MD; several cousins, aunts and uncles.
