Bernadine Mae Kistler of St. Michaels died on Sunday, December 17, 2000 at the Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 83.

Born in Emmaus, PA on October 6, 1917, she was the daughter of the late Oliver and Mabel Miller Stortz. She married Donald Stephen Kistler in 1935 and they made their home in Emmaus.

In 1956, she moved to St. Michaels and she and her husband opened Kistler's, a grocery store in Easton on the corner of Dover and Locust Streets. They ran it for over 20 years until a decline in Mr. Kistler's health forced them to sell. Mr. Kistler died in 1978. Mrs. Kistler was a member of the Grace Lutheran Church, Easton and the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum.

Mrs. Kistler is survived by a daughter, Anne Wheeler of West Melbourne, FL; three sisters, Geraldine Miller, Janet Miller, and Marlene Miller, all of Allentown, PA; 8 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great-grandchildren. A daughter, Jean Lewis, and a brother, Clarence Miller, are deceased.

Funeral services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein, & Newnam Funeral Home, Easton on Friday, December 22, 2000 at 1:00 PM. Burial will be in Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
