A Funeral Liturgy for Bernard “Bernie” Clark of Bozman, MD will be celebrated at St. Michaels Catholic Chapel, St. Michaels, MD on Wednesday, April 14, 2004 at 12:00 noon. Mr. Clark died on Wednesday, April 7, 2004 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 79.

Born April 12, 1924 in New Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late James and Catherine Matlock Clarke. He lived in Pennsylvania for most of his life, attending Old Family Grad School, Blythe Township High School, Penn State and graduating from St. Joe’s in Philadelphia.

Mr. Clark served in the Navy during World War II. After the war, he returned to civilian life to start his career at Westinghouse. He continued on to the Philadelphia Gear Corporation, retiring from there in 1987 as the Director of Purchasing.

An avid boater, Mr. Clark and his wife Peggy moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland to live out their retired days in a home they had designed and built together on Broad Creek. Mr. Clark stayed active in his retirement: volunteering at the Audobon Society’s Pickering Creek, and holding leadership positions in the St. Ann and Joachim Society and Antique Boat Club. Mr. Clark was also a docent at the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum. His favorite job at the museum was educating classes of local students about

blue crabs, oysters and the history of the Bay.

His wife, Margaret M. "Peggy" Finegan Clark died April 16, 2002.

Mr. Clark is survived by a son, Kevin G. Clark and his wife Suzanne of Sudbury, Mass; two daughters, Susan C. Clark of Phoenixville, PA and Megan Render of Catonsville, MD; a brother, James Clarke of New Philadelphia, PA; and two grandchildren, Andrew Clark and Matthew Clark.
