October 4, 1935 - August 31, 2014

Bernard Joseph Hoover, 78, of Easton, MD, passed away suddenly at his home on the morning of August 31, 2014. Mr. Hoover was born in Patton, PA, on October 4, 1935, son of the late Lewis S. Hoover and Susan Murphy Hoover.

Bernard was a devout Catholic who had a passion for golf and was an ardent fan of the Pittsburgh Steelers, Pirates, and Penguins. He served proudly in the United States Navy. He retired as a vice president of finance for a railroad construction company, and afterwards founded his own consulting firm. Bernard led his life with integrity and honor, and lived for his children and grandchildren. Bernard will be dearly missed.

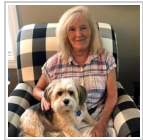
