Bernard Dennis Rogers of Grasonville died at his home on January 10, 2012. He was 67.

Born in Baltimore on May 14, 1944, he was the son of the late Bernard Francis and Dolores Taylor Rogers. Mr. Rogers served in the United States Navy right out of high school. After his time in the service, he became a master plumber and gas fitter. In 2003, he moved to the Eastern Shore with his wife, Margaret, so that the couple could spend more time with family and around the water. Mr. Rogers especially enjoyed fishing, crabbing, and spending time with his grandchildren.
