



## Bernard Vincent Tomardy

December 2, 1943 - February 11, 2014

Bernard Vincent Tomardy died on February 11, 2014, at Anne Arundel Medical Center after a long struggle with esophageal cancer. He was 70.

Born on December 2, 1943, to the late Vincent and Lola (Sokolowski) Tomardy, he grew up in Point Lookout, Seat Pleasant and Bowie. He graduated from Suitland High School and then served in the Army from 1967-1971 during Vietnam.

Bernie married Barbara Jean "BJ" Alexander in 1975. He spent his career with NASA at Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt as Security Communications and retired in 2005 as Branch Head of IT Security. They resided in Stevensville, MD from 1979 where Bernie was very active in the Kent Island Elks serving on various committees and as a past Exhaulted Ruler.

Bernie was an honorary lifetime member of United Community VFD, Island Entertainment "DJ Bernie," American Legion 278, and VFW Post 7464. He is survived by his wife, BJ, and his daughter, Amanda Lynn Tomardy, of Stevensville.

A celebration of Bernie's life will be held on Sunday, March 2, 2014, from 2-4 p.m. at the KI Elks Lodge, 2525 Romancoke Rd, Stevensville, MD.

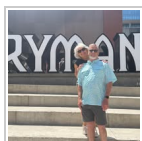
