Bernard Reed “Bernie” Kauffman of Easton died at Talbot Hospice House on Sunday, January 9, 2005. He was 86.

Born on November 24, 1918, he grew up in the Fairbank area of Tilghman Island, where he graduated from Tilghman High School in 1933. He then worked briefly for Baltimore Gas and Electric and in 1943 was inducted into the U. S. Navy. Following his Honorable Discharge in 1946 he returned to the Eastern Shore where he worked at various jobs until 1964 when he purchased the store in Harmony known as “Harmony Markets” where he remained until 1991 when he sold the business and retired.

Mr. Kauffman was a very devoted member of the E. E. Streets Post # 5118 V.F.W. in Easton where he held the position of Quarter Master for 32 years. He was also the founder of the Little League Team on Tilghman Island which was formed in the early 1960's.

Mr. Kauffman is survived by a daughter, Doris Motovidlak and her husband John of Tilghman; a grand-son, John Motovidlak Jr. and his wife April of Wittman; a grand-daughter, Dawn Pipkin and her husband Thomas of Baltimore; and one great-granddaughter, Macy Faye Motovidlak.
