



Bernard Walter Jedrowicz

September 15, 1930 - January 10, 2010

Bernard Walter Jedrowicz died Sunday, January 10, 2010 at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. He was 79.

Born on September 15, 1930 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late, Walter Jedrowicz and Helen Sowinsky. He graduated from City College High School before enlisting in the U.S. Army and Marine Corps Reserves until 1950. He began his career with the Social Security Administration while he attended the University of Baltimore from which he graduated with a Bachelors of Science in 1960. He married Mary Ecker in 1962 and they resided in Locust Point until moving to Cape St Clair in 1973 and later Kent Island in 1979. He worked for the State of Maryland as an administrator in the Toll Facility at the Harbor Tunnel, Key Bridge, and the William Preston Lane Memorial Bridge (Bay Bridge) before working at the Nice Bridge where he retired in 1996.

He was an active member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church, a Knights of Columbus 4th degree Knight, member of the VFW #7464, Bay Country Moose, Kent Island Elks, American Legion #278, and a member of the Queen Anne's County Liquor Board.

Bernard is survived by his wife, Mary E. Jedrowicz of Chester, MD; two sisters, Sophie Ross of Brooklyn, MD and Ceile Baier of Dundalk, MD. He is

preceded in death by his daughter, Andrea Jedrowicz, sisters, Victoria Jedrowicz and Tilly Tucker, and brother, Joseph Jedrowicz.

A memorial mass will be held on Thursday, January 14, 2010 at St Christopher's Catholic Church, 1861 Harbor Drive, Chester, MD at 11 am. A fellowship will follow the service.
