



## Bernice Marshall

Bernice Marshall of Chestertown, Maryland died on Saturday, June 12, 2004 following a battle with cancer. She was 66.

Born in Philadelphia, PA on January 7, 1938, she was the daughter of Ethel Mae Dorricott Balch of Seminole, FL and the late Royal G. Balch. Following her graduation in 1955 from Ridley Township High School, she worked with G.E. as an administrative assistant for six years. In 1962 she married Jack Marshall and raised their family for the next ten years. In 1973, she returned to the workforce as an administrative assistant with The American Society of C.L.U's. She retired in 1986 and in 1992, she and her husband moved to Chestertown, MD. Mr. Marshall died in 1994.

She was a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club where she was the first woman commodore and enjoyed playing golf with the women's golf group. She was also a member of First United Methodist Church in Chestertown, MD, the All Seasons Garden Club, Past Fleet Captain of the Davis Creek Yacht Club, the Kent Narrows Power Squadron, Women's League of Washington College, and volunteered with K.A.R.T. She enjoyed sailing "Gone with the Wind" a 30-foot Catalina, playing golf, and tennis.

In addition to her mother, she is survived by a son, Bradford Chamlee

Marshall of Media, PA; a daughter, Laura Marshall Caso of Warrington, PA; a brother, John Balch of Wilmington, DE; two grandchildren, Michael and Kimberly Pellegrino of Warrington, PA and a companion, Marvin Schlenker of Chestertown, MD.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, June 16, 2004 at 11:00 at First United Methodist Church in Chestertown, MD where relatives and friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Interment will be in St. Paul's Cemetery near Chestertown.
