



Mrs Bernice L Warner

October 14, 1926 - May 28, 2019

Bernice Louise (Kelley) Warner of Bel Air, MD died on May 28, 2019 at Gilchrist Hospice Center in Towson, MD. She was 92.

Born in Rock Hall, Maryland on October 14, 1926 she was the daughter of the late George and Mary Louise Hudson Kelley. She was a 1945 graduate of Rock Hall High School, and moved to Baltimore for work. She soon moved back to Rock Hall where she married John Jiles Warner on July 1, 1950. Mrs. Warner would drive a school bus while she raised her family.

In 1965, they moved to Havre de Grace, MD and following her husband's retirement they moved to Vero Beach, FL, returning to Bel Air in 1997.

Throughout her life, wherever she resided, she considered Rock Hall her home.

Mrs. Warner was a member of Hopewell United Methodist Church in Havre de Grace, MD.

Her husband predeceased her on April 8, 2012.

She is survived by her children : J. Keith Warner and wife Tammy Warner of Bel Air MD, and Pamela Tetrick of Lewisville, TX, four grandchildren: Katie Stachowski, Kristen Sobel, Becky Cavaliere, and Brandi Proctor, along with six great grandchildren: Josephine Stachowski, Thomas Stachowski, Kinsley Sobel, Braylen Jackson, Branden Jackson, and Austin Proctor.

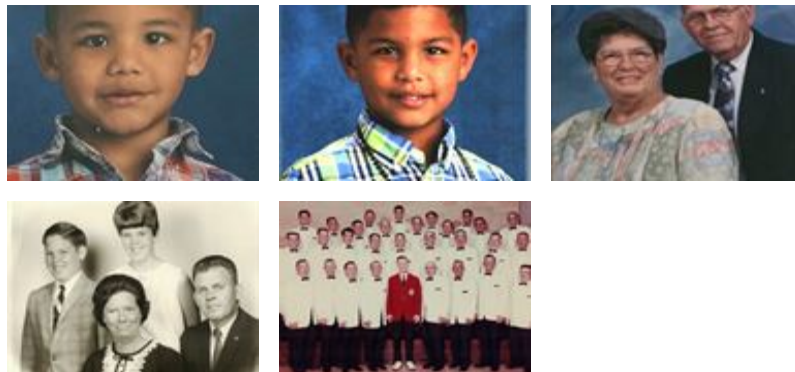

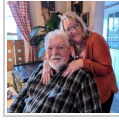
