April 29, 1946 - October 12, 2013

Bert Edward Robertson from Queenstown, MD, died Saturday, October 12, 2013, at Baltimore Washington Medical Center. He was 67.

Born On April 29, 1946, in Cheverly, MD, he was the son of the late Bert Gilliland and Edna May Mackintosh Robertson. Bert graduated from Woodward Preparatory School for Boys Class of 1965. He then attended Towson State University. He married Sharon Lough of Rising Sun, MD, making their home in Oxon Hill until 1974 when they moved to Chester, then moving to Queenstown in 1984.

Bert worked as a pharmaceutical representative for Merrell National Pharmaceutical which became Aventis Pharmaceutical retiring in 2000. He was a member of the Kent Island Yacht Club, Kent Island United Methodist Church, and an early active member of MADD speaking to many high school classes. In 1978 Bert and a few others helped establish the Kent Island Youth Soccer League.

Bert is survived by his wife, Sharon Robertson of Queenstown, MD; a son, Andy Robertson and his wife Megan of Centreville, MD; grandchildren, Michael Brian Robertson and Samantha Nichole Robertson both of Centreville, MD; brother, Bobby L. Jones, Jr. of Swansea, IL; sisters, Sheila Green of Huntingtown, MD, and Judith R. Adams of Ronan, MT. He was

predeceased by a son, Brian Robertson, who died in 1981.

A visitation will be on Wednesday, October 16, 2013, from 2-4 p.m. and 6-8 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Chester, MD. A memorial service will be on Thursday, October 17, 2013, at 11 a.m. in Kent Island United Methodist Church, Chester, MD. Burial will be private in Stevensville Cemetery.
