Bertha I. Grunden of Easton, MD, died at Talbot Hospice on March 28, 2013. She was 99.

Born in Preston on November 5, 1913, she was the daughter of the late, Nathaniel L. and Elice Perry Blades. After attending public school, she worked on the family farm for a number of years. A resident of Easton since the 1940's, she had been employed by Yale Underwear or its predecessor since 1943. She retired in 1994.

Her husband, William T. Grunden whom she married in February, 1936, died in February 1991.
