RIDGELY: Berton John Fuchs of Ridgely passed away on Friday evening, March 20, 2009 at Easton Memorial Hospital, Easton MD. HE was 48 years old.

Born on May 14, 1960 in Salisbury, MD he was the son of Ernest D. Fuchs of Easton, MD and the late Patsy Ray Wittke of Preston.

Bert, as he was affectionately known by friends and family, grew up in Centreville, Kent Island and Easton.
