Bessie Ireland Anthony of Centreville, Maryland died on May 25, 2008 at Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 90 years old.

Mrs. Anthony was born on May 19, 1918 on a farm in Centreville, Maryland to the late James Thomas Ireland and Susan Francis Porter. She graduated from Centreville High School and went on to work at Goldstein's Department Store and then the Centreville National Bank. She continued her career as Chief Telephone Operator with C & P Telephone Company where she worked for over 20 years, later retiring as a teacher's aide with Queen Anne's County Public Schools.
