



Beth Riggs Hall

April 18, 1971 - February 7, 2019

Beth Hall's life ended unexpectedly at Easton Memorial Hospital on February 7, 2019. She was 47 years old.

Beth was born in 1971 in Hershey, PA, and graduated from Middleburg High School in Middleburg PA. She had been a resident of Trappe, MD, since 2002. Beth worked as a school counselor at Easton Middle School for 16 years. Beth had earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Grove City College and a Master's in Counseling from the University of Kansas. She briefly served in the United States Coast Guard between college and graduate school.

Beth is survived by her husband of 21 years, Chris Hall; her parents, George and Collette Riggs (of Easton); her brother, Paul Riggs; and her two dear dogs, Mitch and Sandy.

Beth was a private person who valued her close friendships more than she likely ever expressed. She believed in a society that is accepting of all people and tried to contribute to that vision in her own measured ways. As a school counselor, she was an advocate for students who hadn't yet developed their voice and sought to teach young adolescents' responsibility and compassion in their relationships with others. She was very practical and independent, yet empathetic and understanding.

Beth loved animals and went to great lengths to care for her rescued canine pets. She enjoyed reading, doing puzzles, and traveling in her RV with her husband and dogs. Beth was also a long-time member at the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship at Easton.

A memorial service will be held to honor her memory at St. Mark's Church in Easton on Saturday, February 16, 2019 ,at 1 p.m. A reception will follow.

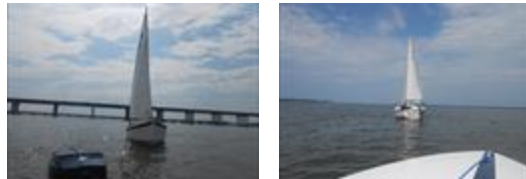
