Betsy Fulton Pusey of Easton died Saturday, March 5 at Genesis Healthcare – The Pines. She was 84.

Born in Brosville, VA, on February 15, 1927, Betsy was the daughter of the late Elizabeth Hundley and William Fulton. She was one of six children. The family moved to Danville, VA, where she graduated from G. W. High School. She then attended Averett College. She met and married Carl L. Pusey in October 1947. They eventually moved to Easton, where Betsy worked in the grain department at Bayshore Foods. They shared 60 years together, before his death in 2008.
