



## Bette S. Edgell

April 9, 1927 - June 21, 2008

Bette Stevens Edgell of Easton, MD died on Saturday, June 21, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 81.

Born April 9, 1927 in Philadelphia, PA, she was the daughter of the late James Earle and Elizabeth LeCompte Stevens. As a child she moved with her family to Talbot County where she attended school in Oxford and then in 1944 graduated from Easton High School. She worked as a secretary-bookkeeper at Royer & Barto in Easton until her marriage in 1962 to Sherman E. Edgell. She then worked with her husband in the mobile home sales business until retiring in 1970. Mr. Edgell died November 25, 2000.

She was a member of First Baptist Church in Easton.

Mrs. Edgell is survived by her step-son Lewis Ray Edgell of Midlothian, VA; her sister, Evelyn M. Lane of Preston; four nieces and nephews and several great nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband she was predeceased by a sister, Dorothy Quatham, who died October 15, 2004.
