Bettina Louise Billingslea of Oxford, MD died on Monday, January 5, 2009 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD. She was 91.

Born April 10, 1917 in Brookline, MASS, she was a graduate of Rogan's Hall and The Erskine School. She did volunteer work all of her life. Locally she was a volunteer at the Oxford Library, the Oxford Museum and the Customs House.
